Successful presenters will be notified in December 2006. Cases will be presented with the aid of Powerpoint and those selected must be submitted electronically by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2007.

The Thoracic Surgical Session will take place between 10.45 and 12.00 on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2007.
